THE WILDERNESS Do you ever notice how busy a world we live in? How much there is to think about? It's easy to feel stressed, anxious, uncertain. Over the last few years scientific studies have evidenced the benefits of being still and silent. Many people have their own quiet places where they can seek out stillness and silence. In this Sunday's Gospel {Mark 1:12-15} we hear that Jesus was also drawn to a quiet place just before he stepped into his public mission, the "wilderness". For the Jewish people in Jesus's day, the "wilderness" was a place associated with searching and questioning. The solitude and lack of distractions there helped a person focus on what was important. In the wilderness a person could be alone with God, listen to his voice, and discern God's plan for them. Jesus spent forty days in the "wilderness", pondering over the words of scripture he had learned while growing up. Unsurprisingly at the end of his forty days, when Jesus was tested by the devil, his responses were founded on scripture. He'd let God's words shape him and understood how they helped live life to the full. That's why the Church encourages us to listen to and read scripture carefully, so we allow God's words to inspire and guide us.
