SAINT MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL

At the back of the nave of the Church where the piety stall is there is a stained glass window of St Michael the Archangel inserted to commemorate the re-building of St. Peter's by Fr. Michael Walshe, parish priest (1946-1967). A new statue has been erected of St. Michael the Archangel in the vacant alcove. This statue came from St. Michael and All Angels Anglican Church Caldmore, Walsall in memory of Edward Foizen vicar from 1921-1954. The statue was rescued by a parishioner David Harrison.
