3rd Sunday Advent - Gaudete Sunday



So, who is coming? John the Baptist is asked about the coming of the Messiah - is it him {John 1:6-8, 19-28}? He affirms his role as a witness to speak for the light, by pointing to the one who stands among the crowd unknown to them, who is coming after him. Paul then reminds us that we are still waiting patiently {1 Thessalonians 5:16-24}: God has called you, and he will not fail you. This is why we as God's people rejoice in his care, made visible in his promises, fulfilled in Jesus.

The third Sunday of Advent is traditionally called Gaudete Sunday since it is Latin word meaning "rejoice." and is the is the first word in the entrance antiphon conveying the joyful message. This Sun-

day we light the rose candle, often called the Shepherd's Candle or the Joy Candle, on the Advent wreath instead of a purple candle and the priest wears a rose-coloured chasuble. The third Sunday in Advent shifts us from a tone of expectation of Christ's coming to one of rejoicing at the arrival of God's kingdom with the coming of Jesus. It is a joyful reminder that our salvation is near.
