₩WHAT IS LOVE?

We all at some point try and

answer this question. The Holy Bible teaches us that **God is Love** (1 John 4:19). Moreover we learn that this love came and lived among us in the person of Jesus of Nazareth (1 John 4:9). The answer to the question, 'What is love?', is: 'Love is a Person, and this Person is God made flesh' (John 1:14). It is why we <u>kneel in wonder</u> during the Creed at Christmastime when we say: "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man." This is be-

cause God did not come as a powerful man but as a baby, vulnerable in His mother's arms in the lowliness of a stable amongst the cattle. The baby Jesus shows us that Love is not power but the outstretched arms of a baby in need. The angels sing to the Shepherds of this love: "Glory to God in the highest and peace to people of good will" (Luke 2:14). If God's love comes to us, we are open to the baby Jesus' outstretched arms and that peace is for us too. A peace we can share. Don't you think the world needs peace above all else? The world cannot give itself peace because the world is always after power—there is fighting everywhere not just in Syria and the terrorist violence we see on TV. Our own streets and homes are less and less peaceful. Jesus says at the Last Supper "Peace I leave you, my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives" (John 14:27). This is a peace that is not born in power, but love and so it must have the features of the love of Jesus in the manger—the hand held out. Perhaps hold out your hand in peace to those around you this Christmas.
