

THE TRANSFIGURATION

Today, the Church meditates on the Transfiguration of Jesus in the presence of the three disciples who joined him on the mountain {Matthew 17:1-9}. The Transfiguration takes place after the first announcement of the death of Jesus. This announcement had confused the disciples and especially Peter. The text describes the transfiguration in a way that makes us aware of



how this unusual experience of Jesus was able to help the disciples overcome the crisis in which they found themselves.
